Thomas A. Catalano, an attorney duly admitted to practice law before the Courts of the State of New York, hereby affirms the following to be true under the penalties of perjury:

- 1. I am a member of Lester Schwab Katz & Dwyer, LLP, attorneys for defendants Law Offices of Michael T. Doudna and Michael T. Doudna (collectively, "Doudna"). I make this affirmation in support of Doudna's motion to dismiss the complaint on the grounds that the court lacks personal jurisdiction over Doudna, a California attorney, and for an award of sanctions based upon the commencement of a frivolous action.
- 2. As is more fully set forth in the annexed affidavits of Michael T. Doudna, Esq. and Harmony Kenney, and the accompanying memorandum of law, this court lacks personal jurisdiction over Doudna. Doudna practices law only in the State of California. He has no contacts with New York. The passive, minimally interactive internet blog maintained by him does not suffice to confer personal jurisdiction.
- 3. Further, plaintiffs did not have a reasonable basis to believe that personal jurisdiction could be obtained over Doudna in New York. It is apparent that plaintiffs' strategy was to sue everyone and anyone (79 defendants are named), regardless of whether any good faith basis existed to establish personal jurisdiction, with the goal of exacting multiple nuisance value settlements that would aggregate to a substantial sum.
